

Mission Trip 2017 – Parts List

What To Bring on Mission with you

A great Attitude and willingness to work (not optional)

Layover Stuff:

Overnight bag, **separate from main luggage**

Must contain: sleep clothes, toiletries, extra clothes, some kind of Sunday clothes

Bedding: Pillow, Sleeping bag/sheet & blanket, air mattress (optional) (as compact as possible)

Bible, Notepad, Pen(s)

Regular Stuff

Tennis Shoes/Sneakers/Hiking Shoes/Boots i.e. NOT FLIP FLOPS

Flip flops are permitted but will not to be permitted to be worn to sites for safety purposes!

Finger-tip length shorts

T-shirts: **NO** spaghetti straps, **NO** halter-top's and **NO** strapless

Sleeveless shirts **MUST BE HEMMED** to be worn and must not be revealing **AT ALL**.

No Shirts Depicting Violence or Drugs or Alcohol

Other needed clothing items as needed

At **Least** one pair of jeans **AND** a sweater/light jacket...just in case

Toiletries:

Washcloth/Loofah etc.,

One or two Towels,

Hygiene products (tooth paste, soap, shampoo, **DEODERANT**, etc.)

Sunscreen and Off

Dirty Clothes Bag

Other Things:

Snacks of your choice (YOUR RESPONSIBILITY)

Flash Light

Extra spending cash (Your Discretion)

Camera (optional)

What **Not** to Bring on Mission

Fireworks or explosives of any kind

Weapons (knives (pocket knife ok), guns, Tasers, etc.)

Drugs, Alcohol, or Tobacco

ANYTHING for Pranks (i.e. Shaving cream (you will not need to shave on this trip) etc.)

Disrespect for adults and others attending

MP3 players/electronics of any kind

EAR BUDS or Headphones will ONLY be permitted while driving to and from Utah

Cell phones are permitted, but **must be off during work hours**, otherwise, they WILL be taken up.

Please use good judgment when packing for mission trip and don't pack anything that will be distracting or destructive to others or their property. And please, please BE MODEST in your apparel!
